

**You already know what

it does to BOYS.**

This card is equivalent to the amount of tissue missing from an adult male's penis after **circumcision**. It represents the **foreskin**, which is amputated from 20% of the world's males by force. The foreskin contains 240 feet of nerves with thousands of erogenous nerve endings, including the **frenulum** and the **ridged band** — the two most sexually sensitive parts of the penis.

This 15 square inch area also protects the sensitivity of the **glans** (the head of the penis) by keeping it moist and covered, much the same way that an eyelid protects the eye. When the foreskin is removed, the glans and remaining inner foreskin slowly become hard and callused — a process called **keratinization**. The result is a further decline in sexual feeling.

No national medical association in the world recommends routine male circumcision. It's **his** penis. Shouldn't it be **his** choice?
